

## Invitation for Bids (IFB)

1. The Romanian Government through the Ministry of Public Finance on behalf of the Ministry of Health has received a Loan from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development toward the cost of the Health Sector Reform - Improving Health System Quality and Efficiency Project Management Unit (HSRIHSQEP PMU) and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to payments under the contract resulting from this IFB for procurement of "Equipment for Burn Units".
2. The Ministry of Health - Project Management Unit now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for procurement of the following goods:
  - LOT 1: Operating room equipment (7 item types);
  - LOT 2: Surgical instruments kits (3 item types);
  - LOT 3: Washing and sterilization equipment (6 item types);
  - LOT 4: Anesthesia machines, vital signs monitor, and ceiling consoles for fluids and electric circuits distribution (5 item types);
  - LOT 5: Patient intubation systems (2 item types);
  - LOT 6: Skin Laser Doppler system (1 item type);
  - LOT 7: Surgical Microscope (1 item type);
  - LOT 8: Burnt patient washing equipment (1 item type);
  - LOT 9: Skin grafting equipment (4 item types);
  - LOT 10: Surgical systems (4 item types).
3. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank's *Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers January 2011* ("Procurement Guidelines"), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.
4. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information from the Management Unit of the World Bank Project (1-3, Cristian Popișteanu St., 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, room 236, Sector 1, Bucharest, Romania) and inspect the bidding documents during office 10:00 to 16:00 hours local time on all working days, starting with October 25<sup>th</sup>, 2018.

6. Bids must be delivered to the address (1) below at or before: **14:00 hour's local time on December 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018**. Electronic bidding will not be permitted. Late bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the bidders' designated representatives and anyone who choose to attend at the address (2) below at **14:00 hour's local time on December 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018**.
